EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATOR COURSE (EVOC)

Training Information & Form

EVOC Course: Two Day Course – Offered on Saturday and Sunday

Day One: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – Classroom Training

Day Two: 8:00 a.m. till ? (Groups of 5 or 6 every hour) Hands-on Training

Requirements to attend an EVOC Course:

- ❖ You must attend Saturday and Sunday to get NYS OFP&C Credit.
- ❖ You need to bring your full size pumper on Sunday. (Host may allow you to use theirs)
- ❖ The hands-on training on Sunday will take approximately 2 hours and we will set up a schedule on Saturday once we have all of the VFDs present.
- ❖ It is not required, but highly recommended that your training officer be present both days.
- ❖ **To get the NYS OFPC credit, BOTH the inside and skill course must be completed.**

Requirements to host an EVOC Course:

- ❖ Ideal class size 25-40 drivers.
- ❖ The facility needs to have a screen for projection unit (Utica provides computer equipment).
- ❖ Ability to cook food or have food brought in.
- ❖ For hands-on training – large parking lot in town and 150 cones are needed.

Bob Faugh, one of our EVOC Trainers, is AAA certified to teach the NYS Insurance/Point reduction program for a fee in Western & Central NY and Can make arrangement for the rest of NYS.
